- 1. The Explanatory Statement and reasons for the proposed Special Business pursuant to Section 102 read with Section 110 of the Act setting out material facts are appended herein below.
- For this purpose, the Company has entered into an agreement with National Securities Depository Limited ("NSDL") for facilitating voting through electronic means, as the authorized agency. The procedure for evoting is explained under the Notes provided with this Postal Ballot Notice.
- 3. The Board of Directors has appointed Mr. Adesh Tandon (FCS No.2253, C.P. No.1121) Proprietor of M/s. Adesh Tandon & Associates, Company Secretaries, Kanpur as the Scrutinizer for conducting the postal ballot through the e-voting process in a fair and transparent manner and he has communicated his willingness to be appointed for the said purpose.
- 4. The remote e-voting commences from 9:00 A.M. (IST) on Sunday, 19th March, 2023 and ends at 5:00 P.M. (IST) on Monday, 17th April, 2023.
- 5. The Postal Ballot Notice is being send to the Members of the Company whose names appear on the Register of Members/List of Beneficial Owners as received from the Depositories as on Friday, 10th March, 2023 the "Cut-off" date. The Members, whose names appear in the Register of Members/List of Beneficial Owners as on Friday, 10th March, 2023, are entitled to vote on the Resolution set forth in this Notice. A person who is not a member as on the Cut-off date should treat this Notice of Postal Ballot for information purpose only.
- 6. In line with MCA Circulars, the Postal Ballot Notice is being sent only by electronic mode to those members whose e-mail addresses are registered with the Company/Depositories. Members may please note that the Postal Ballot Notice will also available on the Company's website <u>www.kothariproduts.in</u> and on websites of the Stock Exchanges i.e. BSE Limited at <u>www.bseindia.com</u> and NSE Limited at <u>www.nseindia.com</u>
- 7. Members who have not registered their e-mail addresses are requested to register the same in respect of shares held in electronic form with the Depository through their Depository Participant(s) and in respect of shares held in physical form by writing to the Company's Registrar and Share Transfer Agent, M/s. In accordance with the provisions of the MCA Circulars, Shareholders can vote only through the remote e-voting process. Physical copies of the Postal Ballot Notice and pre-paid business reply envelopes are not being sent to shareholders for this Postal Ballot.
- 8. Resolution passed by the shareholders Postal Ballot are deemed to have passed as if they have been passed at a General Meeting of the shareholders.
- The voting rights of Members shall be in proportion to their shares of the paid-up equity share capital of the Company as on 10th March, 2023, being the Cut-off date fixed for the purpose.
- 10. In compliance with Sections 108 and 110 of the Act and rules made there under, the MCA Circulars and Regulation 44 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, the Company has also provided the facility to the shareholders to exercise their votes electronically on the resolution through the e-voting service facility arranged by National Securities Depository Limited. The instructions for e-voting are provided as part of this Postal Ballot Notice.
- 11. Shareholders desiring to exercise their vote through the e-voting process are requested to read the instructions in the Notes under the section "Government information and instructions relating to e-voting" in this Postal Ballot Notice. The voting period commences on Sunday, 19th March, 2023 at 9:00 A.M. (IST) and ends at 5:00 P.M. (IST) on Monday, 17th April, 2023 (both days inclusive). The e-voting module shall be disabled by NSDL for voting thereafter.
- 12. The Scrutinizer will submit its report to the Chairman after the completion of scrutiny and result of the voting by Postal Ballot through the e-voting process will be announced by the Chairman or Company Secretary & Compliance Officer of the Company duly authorized, on or before Wednesday, 19th April, 2023 and will also be displayed on the website of the Company viz. www.kothariproducts.in besides being communicated to the Stock Exchange viz. BSE Limited, NSE Limited and Depositories. The Scrutinizer's decision on the validity of e-voting will be final.
- 13. Pursuant to Regulation 36(3) of the SEBI Listing Regulations and Secretarial Standard on General Meetings issued by the Institute of Company Secretaries of India, the relevant details of Directors being appointed are annexed to this notice.
- 14. The resolution, if passed, by the requisite majority, shall be deemed to have been passed on the last date specified by the Company for e-Voting i.e. Monday, 17th April, 2023. Further, resolution passed by the Members through Postal Ballot is deemed to have been passed effectively at a General Meeting.

- 17. The General information and instructions for Shareholders for remote e-voting are as under:

NSDL e-Voting System – For Remote e-voting.

The remote e-voting period begins on 19th March, 2023 at 9:00 A.M. and ends on 17th April, 2023 at 5:00 P.M. The remote e-voting module shall be disabled by NSDL for voting thereafter. The Members, whose names appear in the Register of Members / Beneficial Owners as on the record date (Cut-off date) i.e. 10th March, 2023, may cast their vote electronically. The voting rights of the shareholders shall be in proportion to their share in the paid-up equity share capital of the Company as on the aforesaid Cut-off date.

How do I vote electronically using NSDL e-Voting system?

- 5. Password details for shareholders other than Individual shareholders are given below:

Step 2: Cast your vote electronically on NSDL e-Voting system.

How to cast your vote electronically on NSDL e-Voting system?

- 1. After successful login at Step 1, you will be able to see all the companies "EVEN" in which you are holding shares and whose voting cycle.
- 2. Select "EVEN" of company for which you wish to cast your vote during the remote e-Voting period.
- 3. Now you are ready for e-Voting as the Voting page opens.
- 4. Cast your vote by selecting appropriate options i.e. assent or dissent, verify/modify the number of shares for which you wish to cast your vote and click on "Submit" and also "Confirm" when prompted.
- 5. Upon confirmation, the message "Vote cast successfully" will be displayed.
- 6. You can also take the printout of the votes cast by you by clicking on the print option on the confirmation page.

7. Once you confirm your vote on the resolution, you will not be allowed to modify your vote.

General Guidelines for shareholders

- Institutional shareholders (i.e. other than individuals, HUF, NRI etc.) are required to send scanned copy (PDF/JPG Format) of the relevant Board Resolution/ Authority letter etc. with attested specimen signature of the duly authorized signatory(ies) who are authorized to vote, to the Scrutinizer by e-mail to <u>adesh.tandon11@gmail.com</u> with a copy marked to <u>evoting@nsdl.co.in</u>. Institutional shareholders (i.e. other than individuals, HUF, NRI etc.) can also upload their Board Resolution / Power of Attorney / Authority Letter etc. by clicking on "Upload Board Resolution / Authority Letter" displayed under "e-Voting" tab in their login.
- 2. It is strongly recommended not to share your password with any other person and take utmost care to keep your password confidential. Login to the e-voting website will be disabled upon five unsuccessful attempts to key in the correct password. In such an event, you will need to go through the "Forgot User Details/Password?" or "Physical User Reset Password?" option available on www.evoting.nsdl.com to reset the password.
